**THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS ARE NOW ACCEPTED FOR CURBSIDE RECYCLING**

<b>MATERIAL</b>	<b>WHAT TO RECYCLE</b>	<b>HOW TO PREPARE</b>	<b>DO NOT INCLUDE</b>
<b>PAPER PRODUCTS</b>	Newspapers & glossy inserts Magazines Phone Books Junk (and other) mail Cereal Boxes, packaging, toy boxes, etc. White, colored & computer paper Corrugated Cardboard while shopping, request PAPER BAGS and use to bundle all of the above.	Place newspapers, glossy inserts, magazine, phone books, junk mail, white, colored & computer paper together in paper bags to blue bin. Remove plastic or foil liner from cereal boxes and packaging boxes, place in paper bags. and bundle cardboard, or place in paper bags. Bundle size not to exceed 2 feet x 2 feet. Twine may be used to tie the bundles	DO NOT tape bundles together. DO NOT place in plastic bags. NO wax or foil coated materials NO egg cartons. NO pizza boxes. <b>NOTE:</b> waxed paper products, tissue, paper towels, egg cartons, napkins, and food containers can be easily composted in your back yard.
<b>GLASS</b>	Clear, brown, or green food and beverage container <b>ONLY</b> .	Rinse clean, and place in your bin. Labels, lids and neck rings are okay.	NO light bulbs. NO window glass. NO dishes, glasses, ceramics, PYREX. NO mirrors. NO broken glass.
<b>METAL CANS</b>	All metal cans, tin, steel, aluminum, etc. Aluminum foil and food trays.	Rinse clean, and place in your bin. Labels, lids and neck rings are okay.	NO aerosol cans. NO paint or oil cans.
<b>PLASTICS</b>	Plastic milk, juice, and water jugs. Soda bottles. Detergent bottles. Plastics	Remove lids and flatten bottles, to reduce size, then place in your bin. Label lids and neck rings are okay.	NO plastic bags/wrappings. NO motor oil or antifreeze containers (can be put in trash if empty). NO polystyrene (styrofoam).
